

RECIPE EXCHANGE

Roasted Sweet Potatoes

with Honey and Cinnamon

(adapted from a recipe by Tyler Florence)



This is an easy and delicious side dish that will add flavor not work to your holiday dinner.

Ingredients

4 sweet potatoes, peeled and cut into 1-inch cubes

2 Tbls. extra-virgin olive oil

Butter or margarine--a little or a lot-to taste. (I use 2-3 Tablespoons of room temperature margarine) 1/4 cup of honey

2 Tbls. ground cinnamon (the original recipe calls for 2 teaspoons, but I like cinnamon)
Salt and freshly ground pepper

Directions

Preheat oven to 375 degrees F.

In a medium mixing bowl, add the sweet potato cubes, olive oil, cinnamon, salt and pepper. Mix until all potatoes are coated with oil and spices. Keep mixing bowl for later.

Lay the sweet potatoes out in a single layer on a roasting tray or pan. Cover with foil and roast in the oven for 30 minutes. Remove the foil and continue roasting for another 15-20 minutes, or until tender.

Add butter/margarine and honey in the same mixing bowl and stir until they are mixed. (I add more cinnamon to this honey butter to adjust for your own taste). Take the sweet potatoes out of the oven and transfer them to the mixing bowl stirring gently until all potatoes are coated.

Serve in bowl or platter. (The original recipe used more olive oil, but the butter adds more flavor). This makes 4-5 servings, depending on the size of the potatoes. You can easily double the recipe if you need more servings. If you like them sweeter, add more honey and cinnamon!



GARDENER'S CORNER

DECEMBER weather can be deceptive. Rain, high temperatures or frost are all possibilities. The days will be short and the soil will become cold. During warm spells you can prune fruit trees and vines but only after the leaves have fallen. This indicates that the trees are fully dormant and pruning will not damage living tissue. Don't clip spring blooming shrubs or you will remove this coming years' color.

Roses are blooming but don't feed them this month. Let the dying roses make rose hips which strengthens the overall bush and prepares it for winter. Continue watering until the rains take over. Irrigation should be reduced but not stopped as plant photosynthesis slows down and cold weather dries plants out.

Don't worry that your houseplants don't seem to perky now...they are going dormant just like plants outdoors. Plants need this rest so stop feeding them and water them less frequently. Also, be sure they are not getting blasted with hot air from a hot air vent or fireplace.

The garden is a treasure trove of possibilities for holiday decorations. Pyracantha berries alternated with popcorn make attractive garlands. Herbs too can trim Yule logs, flavor jelly or vinegars, give fragrance to clusters of twigs or wreaths.


Do I need approval if I want to make changes or improvements to my home exterior or landscaping?
