RECIPE EXCHANGE

Spinach, Onion, and Potato Frittata

2 Yukon gold Potatoes (about 12 oz diced)
3 Tbsp olive oil
1 red onion, thinly sliced
Salt and pepper
1 10-oz package frozen chopped spinach,
thawed and squeezed dry
8 large eggs, lightly beaten

Bring a saucepan of salted water to a boil. Add potatoes and cook until just tender, about 8 minutes. Drain and set aside.

In a 10 inch ovenproof skillet, warm olive oil over medium heat. Add onion and cook, stirring often until softened, about 5 minutes. Add potatoes and cook, stirring occasionally, until potatoes begin to brown, about 5 minutes. Stir in spinach, season with salt and pepper.

Preheat broiler to high. Pour eggs into skillet stirring briefly to distribute vegetables. Cook over medium-low heat, sliding a spatula under frittata to occasionally loosen until set underneath but still set on top, about 5 minutes

Place skillet under broiler and cook until top is golden brown, 1-2 minutes. (or cover and heat on medium in the oven). Cut in wedges after it sets a few minutes, similar to pieces of pie.

Serve with a salad for a brunch or with toasted wheat bread for breakfast. Supposedly it serves 4 but it can serve eight if you have salad, or other breakfast item, bagel, etc.

Can serve at lunch with fresh fruit or a fruit salad...so many choices...happy baking

10 min prep, cook about 25 minutes, serves 4-8 depending, cost per serving, \$1.23 and if you eat a fourth of it 341 calories, if you eat an eighth of it the calories would be around 170.

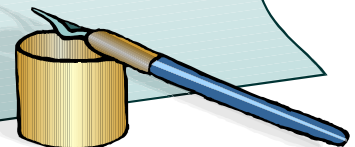
I sprinkled cheddar cheese lightly on mine, so that may increase calorie count slightly.

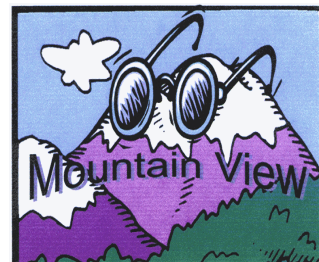
